Prayer to Charlene Richard (1947-1959)

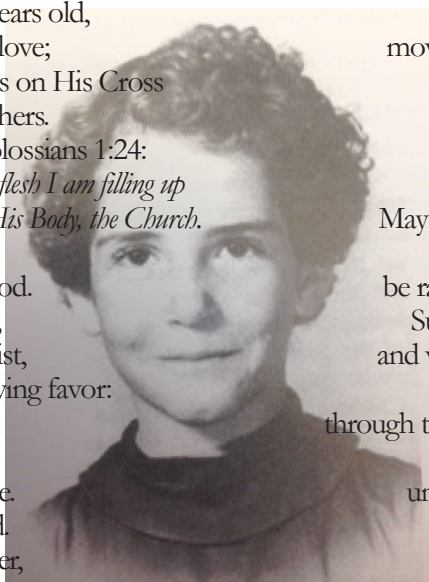
